

# **ADVERTISEMENT FOR PRE-QUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS FOR THE YEAR 2010**

## **CITY OF MANCHESTER DEPARTMENT OF AVIATION MANCHESTER – BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT MANCHESTER, NEW HAMPSHIRE**

The Department of Aviation will accept Prequalification Statements from contractors interested in bidding on upcoming construction projects at Manchester-Boston Regional Airport during calendar year 2010. The projects for which prequalification statements are being accepted are described below. Project descriptions are representative of the types of projects the Department is considering at this time. Actual projects, when undertaken, are expected to be similar to those described. Not all projects are expected to be awarded this year. Contractors who qualify for specific projects shall be considered qualified for any projects the Department deems to be similar in nature.

### **Replacement of In-Ground Snow Melters**

This project is expected to include the complete replacement of some or all of the Airport's in-ground, natural gas-fired snow melters. Work will include demolition and removal of existing snow melters and installation of new snow melting equipment to be supplied by the Airport. Scope to include mechanical, electrical, piping, drainage, excavation, demolition, concrete, bituminous pavement, and incidental work for the complete installation and commissioning of the new snow melting equipment. Cost of project is estimated at \$1,500,000.

### **FY 2010 Parking Garage Repairs**

This project is expected to include replacement of precast panel joint sealants at the stair and elevator towers; application of penetrating corrosion inhibitor; repairs to the crossover slabs, including epoxy injection, painting of steel connections, and application of sealants; and approximately 9000lf of floor joint sealant replacement. Project will take place in an active parking garage and will require coordination, traffic control, and protection of parked vehicles from dust and debris. Cost is estimated at \$250,000.

### **Minor Miscellaneous Parking/Roadway Improvements**

Miscellaneous Parking/Roadway Improvement projects to include parking lot and roadway improvements/construction and utility construction/relocation. Schedule and scope are dependent on need. Cost for each project not to exceed \$250,000.

### **Major Miscellaneous Parking/Roadway Improvements**

Miscellaneous Parking/Roadway Improvement projects to include parking lot and roadway improvements/construction and utility construction/relocation. Schedule and scope are dependent on need. Cost for each project will exceed \$250,000 but is expected to be less than \$1,000,000.

### **Airfield Pavement Repairs and Overlays**

Airfield Pavement Repairs and Overlay projects to include minor pavement repairs, and milling and overlaying portions of airfield taxiways and aprons. Work will be on the secure side of the airport and will require security clearances and badging of employees. Schedule and scope are dependent on need. Cost for each project will be less than \$1,000,000.

### **Misc. Drainage and Wall Repairs**

Miscellaneous drainage and wall repair projects will include repairs to retaining walls and miscellaneous drainage repairs both on the secure and non-secure sides of the airport. Cost for each project to be less than \$100,000.

Contractors may apply for prequalification for one or more of these projects.

Only prequalified contractors will be allowed to bid on Department of Aviation projects requiring pre-qualification.

Product/Material suppliers and subcontractors are **not** required to file for pre-qualification.

Pre-qualification Statements will be accepted at the office of Engineering & Planning, Manchester-Boston Regional Airport, 6 Industrial Drive, Suite 2, Londonderry, New Hampshire 03053 - **until 3 weeks prior to bid for each project.** As such, we encourage interested firms to submit Pre-qualification Statements as soon as possible.

**Individual projects will not be re-advertised if they are adequately represented in this advertisement. It is the sole responsibility of the Contractor to be prequalified within the timeframe stated above. Prequalified contractors will be notified of all bids for which they have been prequalified.**
