QUESTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS

Addendum Item 1.10

There may be a discrepancy in the project documents for which Davis-Bacon Wage Schedule to use for the Project, whether the work is to be considered under the Building Classification Schedule or the Heavy Construction Classification Schedule?

<u>Answer:</u> As noted above under Addendum Item No. 1.04, the Project will no longer be subject to the Davis-Bacon Act Wage requirements since no federal funding will be used. Therefore, the question has become moot and the answer is that Davis-Bacon Wage Rates will not be required.

Addendum Item 1.11

There was a verbal question at the Pre-Bid Meeting that the Design Team felt required an answer in this Addendum, since it had potential pricing ramifications. Will the Portland Cement concrete from the on-site building demolition be allowed to be crushed on-site and re-used as fill material?

<u>Answer:</u> After additional review of the matter since the Pre-Bid Meeting, all Portland Cement concrete from the building demolition WILL NOT be acceptable for on-site crushing and fill material and the material shall be disposed of properly off the site in accordance with Section B-200 Building Demolition and all applicable local, state and federal regulations.


