

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Manchester-Boston Regional Airport serves New Hampshire and the greater Boston region and is poised for growth given North American trends. The impact report estimates employment, wages, and output from on-airport activities, including operations and construction. It also evaluates manufacturing and logistics jobs related to land use at MHT, tourism benefits, and broader fiscal impacts such as property and income taxes.

Under an optimal growth model, meals and room tax revenue from new passengers and visitors would increase by **\$1.6 million** per year.


AIR CARGO

Air Cargo is critical to MHT and the greater New Hampshire economy, with a continued growth in cargo volumes at 5% annual rate since 2015.

MHT is New England's third largest cargo airport, processing more air cargo each year than all other regional airports in New England combined.

FUTURE

MHT is well positioned to capture growing passenger demand due to the positive economic climate in New Hampshire and in the city of Manchester, however, the airport is losing the potential economic output due to passengers not flying out of MHT. With a shift in policy focus and consumer choices, MHT has the potential to yield significant increases in on-airport related economic impacts (below numbers focus on airport operations and excludes on-airport capital investment):
