***RENEWABLE NET ENERGY METERING CREDIT AGREEMENTS FOR OFFSITE
RENEWABLE SYSTEMS***

The City of Manchester, NH, acting by and through its Department of Aviation (hereinafter referred to as the “City”), being a duly and lawfully constituted municipal corporation owning and operating the Manchester-Boston Regional Airport (the “Airport”), is seeking Proposals from qualifying parties (each a “Bidder”) for group net energy metering credits generated by renewable systems less than 5MW located off-site in Eversource New Hampshire territory, pursuant to New Hampshire’s group net energy metering allowances and regulation as described in NH Title XXXIV, Chapter 362-A, RSA Section 362-A:9. The term length of any associated Utility Credit Purchase Agreement(s) is expected to be up to twenty (20) years.

All Proposals must be received via email at procurement@flymanchester.com and at dlong@competitive-energy.com on or before **5:00 P.M. EST on August 28, 2026**. The email subject line should read: **“RESPONSE to Manchester-Boston Regional Airport Renewable Net Metering RFP”** and must include all documents as required by the RFP. One hardcopy shall be delivered to the Airport in accordance with submittal instructions.

The Airport reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals, to waive technicalities and informalities, and to accept the proposal deemed best for the Airport. The Airport will work with the selected Bidder(s) to negotiate agreeable contract terms. Any resulting contract shall be construed under and governed by the Laws of the State of New Hampshire.

Interested parties are encouraged to submit Proposals that conform to the requirements of this RFP. This RFP is being managed on behalf of the Airport by Competitive Energy Services, LLC (“CES”).
